Established in 1979, the School of Nursing is the only nursing school on the South Plains to provide baccalaureate, masters, and doctoral-level education.

As one of the largest TTUHSC schools, the School of Nursing offers programs in Abilene, Lubbock, Odessa, and through distance education.



Undergraduate programs include:

- (1) **Traditional Bachelor of Science in Nursing**, which offers unique opportunities for students who are not yet registered nurses to receive state-of-the-art nursing education;
- (2) **Second Degree Bachelor of Science in Nursing**, a 12-month accelerated program of study for those who already have a bachelor's degree in another field of study and meet other admissions criteria; AND
- (3) **RN to BSN**, which is customized program for a registered nurse to earn a bachelor's degree in nursing in only two semesters.

Graduate programs include:

- (1) **Master's in Nursing** degrees with specializations in administration, education, and various practitioner roles;
- (2) **Post-masters certificates** for nurse practitioners in pediatrics, family, and acute care;
- (3) **Doctor of Nursing Practice**, with tracks in advance practice nursing and executive leadership; AND
- (4) **Ph.D. in Nursing** through a collaboration with Texas Woman's University.
